- No presentation just conference paper for the proceedings (8000 HUF or 25 EUR)

The payment doesn't guarantee the further publication, the paper has to be accepted by the editorial board through review. In case your contribution is not published (e.g. due to failure to comply with deadlines or prescribed format, etc.), the registration fee is not refundable.
